The UMBC Sample Organization shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the University of Maryland Baltimore County's Office of Graduate Student Life and the Graduate Student Association, as well as to the President of the University and his/her designees.

- Section E: Any officer may be removed from membership in *The UMBC Sample Organization* by a two-thirds vote of the Executive Committee. Any officer removed may appeal to the general membership. Said officer shall be considered reinstated with two-thirds approval of the members of *The UMBC Sample Organization*.
- Section F: Any vacancy which may occur in an office shall be filled by an appointment by the remaining members of the Executive Committee pending ratification at the next group meeting.

Article V -- Meetings Section A: The times for regularly scheduled meetings shall be _____.

- Section B: The rules may be suspended by a two-thirds vote of present membership.
