- Not much new business today

Reports

Treasurer [Anuja Yawar]

- Need to introduce Asst. Treasurer when conferring with Ethan and Dawn
- Discussed roles and responsibilities with Amy Cruz (Assistant Treasurer) that they will be sharing
- Hopefully we will be able to finalize GRP committee by the end of this week. → potentially splitting the responsibilities for this role
- Question for Ethan- flow chart that we discussed in previous meeting has to be made before the Senator meeting? Are we presenting the flow chart in that meeting?

- Flow chart will be presented in the Senate Meeting or if it's only E-Council? → Ethan: it's more for the program directors especially who would require more assistance in understanding how GRP process works
 - Follows to be introduced onto the website
 - J.A. and J.H-> want to be looped into the conversation so that everyone is on the same page before it goes to anyone else
- GA'ships come into the federal work study → why GSA doesn't get incorporated into the federal work study in order to get tuition remission
 - Zane: only certain GA'ships are under federal work study requirements, most do not get tuition remission
- Anuja would like clarification on this topic
- Federal work study positions are not mutually inclusive to each other (some of the GSA positions are federal work study)
- Zane: that may not be obtainable since GSA would not academically be able to make ECouncil as GAships
 - J.H→ specifically minimizing the role of administrative GAships as ECouncil
 - Do not receive full tuition reimbursement and specific compliance issues that may make this difficult

- o Election Night Extravaganza will be happening on election day
 - On the 8th → SGA + CFDCL collaboration
 - Food events, activities that will take place
- Will loop Geeta in about how to update the website for voter registration
 - Emily S→ how to see if she's an MD resident?
 - Zane→ if you live in MD, pay tax here, license---> could use Social Security number (?)
 - She may have to go in person but Emily F did it online during the pandemic
- Will reach out to UMD and other graduate students to coordinate efforts for lobbying.
 - Anoosha + Sahara will be having town hall with Zane providing context
 - UMD has talking points about what the bill can do and its potential impact
- Will develop a list of bills of interest so that GSA can vote to support, write testimony and coordinate students to go to Annapolis
 - Will want to coordinate whether GSA will want to be involved in testimony writing and how to organize transportation for spring session
 - A UMD student wanted to get involved in drafting legislation alongside Zane et al. for the upcoming session to do collective bargaining
 - They will reach out to coordinate this on their end and Zane P. will also follow up on this too

- Ethan, myself, and several e-council folks had an Informative meeting with Janet Rutledge about the letter to President Sheares Ashby
 - Last Thursday the 29th
 - UMBC cannot run Retriever Essentials → pay staff and donate space in school but would have to track in order to count towards financial aid package
 - Good meeting with Dr. R and having her as a stakeholder for GSA's position on this
- Working on poster for temporary group being created for the video

 - Emily S → people know the issues and have used channels in place but haven't received adequate response
 - Dr H→ Jennifer and him will send notes about Dr. R's notes on transit meeting
- Dr. H→ no followup/follow through to the planned walkout→ Emily S suggested that some messaging is sent out and Ethan P wanted to see if we could do something at GS fest for mobilitization
- Anoosha: adding ad hoc GAAC committee creation → adding this to the Senate Meeting Agenda
- hanging/lingering points re: letter
 - Will be another round of draft edits on the letter
- Kara: clarification re: committee things
 - University steering committees→ Lydia Stamato
 - Ethan P→ will Kara be wanting to serve again
 - Dawn (Kara's GA supervisor) → Kara was moved off committee that she's been on for 2 years
 - Miscommunication issue according to Ethan P
 - Both ECouncil and Senators can join on the U.S.Cs
